## Conflict Minerals Policy

PSV Wipers Limited is committed to the responsible sourcing of materials and the minerals used within these materials throughout its global supply chain.

In conflict-affected and high-risk areas (“CAHRAs”) the mining and trade of Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten and Gold (“3TGs”) can be used to finance conflict between armed groups, fuel forced labour and other human rights abuses, and support unethical business practices, such as corruption and money laundering. PSV Wipers have no requirement to use these minerals in any products we purchase or manufacture, all product design recognises that the business has no wish to make use of these minerals within the products we produce, or in the processes carried out by PSV Wipers or its supply chain partners.

We understand that the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (“Dodd-Frank”) had no intention to ban procurement of minerals from the DRC and adjoining countries, but to assure procurement from responsible sources in the region. However PSV Wipers have determined that none of our products or components will contain any minerals that fall within the category of “conflict minerals”.
